COVID-19 cases surpassed 500,000 worldwide on Saturday as the new coronavirus continues to spread outside of China, the original epicenter of the outbreak. The total number of cases now stands at 593, 668 as on Saturday. The virus has now killed more than 27,000 people around the world.



PAKISTAN

COVID-19 cases are rampantly increasing in Pakistan. The Government continues to closely monitor the situation and is taking necessary precautionary measures to curtail further spread, while multiple provinces have opted to go into a state of lockdown. Organizations integral to sustaining supply chain, healthcare and food have been deemed essential and can operate during lockdown.

COVID'19 – IMPACT UPDATE

AIR FREIGHT

Entry of any international commercial passenger aircraft is restricted into Pakistan. Also, the operations of domestic schedule commercial airlines are ceased. This may impact transshipment movements. These instructions will remain into effect until lockdown period.

Please note that this suspension is for only passenger aircrafts and freighters are allowed to land or take off. Charters/Freighter services are still operational. Qatar Airways, DHL Airways, Turkish Airlines & Emirates Sky Cargo operating their Cargo flights from Pakistan.

The air freight rates continue to rise with hourly validity and the carriers have withdrawn contractual rates.

The advisory is a temporary measure to restrict spread of Covid-19 and subject to review by the Pakistani Government

Blank sailings are expected in the days to come, as shippers are not able to pick up containers due to shutdown/manpower shortages.

All ports are operational and Vessels are calling Pakistan ports.
